Movie Night is Back!

Proudly announcing the return for 2019 of APC Movie Night – Friday 22 February in the Board Room from 7pm.

The main feature is "Romero" – a biopic of Oscar Romero, Archbishop of San Salvador, who spoke out against the poverty, social injustice, assassinations, and torture, which wracked El Salvador in the late 1970s. He was assassinated in March 1980, while conducting mass in a hospital chapel. A humble and Christlike martyr, who spoke out courageously against the powerful – but always sought their change of heart, rather than their destruction. Seen as an inspiration by the Liberation Theology movement, he rejected any kind of violence – except "la violencia del amor", the violence of love. He was canonised (declared a Saint) in October 2018, and the international airport of El Salvador bears his name.
